DESCRIPTION

Business records of the Arizona Improvement Company, a Tucson real estate corporation. Includes articles of incorporation, by-laws, minutes, financial transactions. Includes records of real estate transactions in the "Fairmount Addition" (now part of the Sam Hughes Neighborhood). Most of the collection is one ledger; there is a small amount of correspondence and stock certificates.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The Arizona Improvement Company was a real estate corporation. Its original members were J. W. Forgeus, William B. Sawtelle, Quintus Monier, Mose Drachman, Vic E. Hanny and George F. Kitt, all prominent Tucson businessmen. They were incorporated in 1907 and went out of business in 1930.
