DESCRIPTION

Small collection of papers concerning the Cababi Consolidated Mining Company in Pima County, Arizona Territory. The papers include letters from John Moore to Charles Drake concerning the management of the mines. Payroll reports listing the workers and miscellaneous receipts for goods are present. Also included is a typewritten report concerning the condition of the company's five mines: the Grand Prize, First Prize, Littlefield, Little Monarch and Petanke, all located in the Cababi Mountains south of Tucson.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The Cababi district was first mined before the Gadsden Purchase as part of Mexico. It was developed enough to have a post office in 1883, but apparently never became a very large mining area.
