SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE: This collection consists of photos and text of an unpublished book documenting examples of ruins of Spanish, Mexican, and early American structures found in southern Arizona. Some of the sites documented here include Presidio San Ignacio de Tubac, Sopori Ranch, Presidio Santa Cruz de Terrenate, San Cayetano de Calabazas Mission, Fort Mason. Also documented are numerous unnamed settlements, mining camps, and other structures. Each image is labeled with a figure number, and an accompanying caption. The images are arranged in numerical order and arranged by era (Spanish, Mexican, early American), in keeping with the author's original order.
