MS 0613 Blue Rock Gun Club Scores of shooters ledger, 1894-1914

DESCRIPTION

Ledger containing shooting scores of club members resulting from competitive shooting of live birds and clay targets in events including tournaments. Lists individuals, sometimes grouped into teams, and their scores, and amounts paid to boys for trapping birds. Tournaments included professionals, a Phoenix team, Tucson team, and Clifton team. Members included A. Rossi, L.J.F. Jaeger, W.A. Julian, H. Steinfeld, J.M. Ronstadt, Kirt L. Hart, and Vivian Mansfield. In later years, women are included in the scores.

HISTORICAL NOTE

Named for the type of clay target used, the Blue Rock Target, the gun club was formed in Tucson and associated with the Tucson Sportsmen's Association and the Arizona Sportsmen's Association for the purposes of competitive trapshooting. It disbanded in 1914.
