#### MS 1338 Lott Brockman Collection 1912 - 1929

### DESCRIPTION

This small collection consists primarily of the military records of Lott Brockman from 1912 to 1927. Records include discharge certificates and promotion notices while in the 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> Inf. Regiments. Two certificates testify to Brockman's membership in the Douglas, AZ chapter of the Masons in 1925 and 1928. One mounted photograph of Brockman in civilian clothes is also present in the collection.

# **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Lott Brockman enlisted into the 24<sup>th</sup> Infantry, United States Army in 1912 from Baltimore, MD where he was employed as an iron moulder. Brockman reenlisted three times and remained in the Army until 1927 when he died. During this period he served with both the 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> Inf. Regiments and was stationed in Douglas, AZ from 1923 until his death. Brockman served overseas in the Philippines and later France during 1917 – 1919. He performed duties in the Quartermaster department and worked as a baker. While in Douglas he joined the Olympia Lodge of Masons and maintained his membership from 1925 to 1928. After his death his remains were moved to the military cemetery at Chattanooga, TN on Feb. 8, 1929.
