The collection records the official organizational records for the Brotherhood of Railway Trainmen, Lodge #460. The collection includes the official membership lists, including dues paid. The minute books cover the activities of the Lodge, including legal cases and grievances filed against the railroad. The records include employee arbitration, grievances and union expenditures.
