## **DESCRIPTION**

### **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Estelle Aubrey Brown, author, was born in New York in 1877. She entered the United States Indian Field Service in 1902 and served in various capacities until 1918. She was married to Silas Armstrong in 1904 until he died in 1907. She married Major Harry Brown in 1918 and he died in 1931. She began writing in 1919 and wrote to describe her experiences with the Indian Agency. She died in 1958.
