DIARY, 1902-1903**

**DESCRIPTION**

The collection contains one handwritten diary written by Maud Buchholz describing a cross-country trip from Chicago to Phoenix in 1902-03. She left for Arizona because of a "bad lung" and traveled by train to Phoenix and then to Tucson. She describes life in Phoenix and Tucson including the layout of streets, the buildings and the people. She describes a picnic visit to the San Xavier del Bac Mission.
