# DESCRIPTION

Location notices, account book, correspondence and a printed report concerning the Bunker Hill Mining Company located in Cochise County. The first location notices were filed by John B. Anderson in 1888. The collection also includes the notices filed by George Kitt in 1921. The bulk of the collection contains papers from when George F. Kitt was the owner including a business ledger from 1921 to 1924. A 1902 pamphlet describes the conditions of the mines and contains printed photographs.

The Bunker Hill Mines were first developed in the 1880s and seem to have gone through a number of hands. The Bunker Hill Mining Company (of Tombstone) included the Mammoth, the Rattlesnake and Bunker Hill Mines and was adjacent to the Tombstone Consolidated Mines Company.
