BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Pioneer merchant and mining man; Robert Burmister settled in Prescott in 1874 and developed mining interests in Yavapai County. He married Margaret F. Bashford, a daughter of Coles Bashford, former governor of Wisconsin. Later he was president of L. Bashford and Company, then established T. H. Burmister and Sons. He served as Mayor of Prescott in 1900 for one term.
