#### **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Pioneer merchant; born in 1869 and believed to be the first boy born in Tucson of American parents. He was the eldest son of Philip and Rosa Drachman. Harry Drachman worked for Zeckendorf's for thirteen years, then operated his own shoe store, the Harry A. Drachman Shoe Company, from 1897 to 1927. Drachman took control of the Criterion Shoe Company in 1922; it had been incorporated by J. Knox Corbett, H.S. Corbett, and Max M. Brodie in 1917. He served as City Treasurer from 1895 to 1898, and as Pima County Treasurer until 1902. He was a School Trustee from 1916 to 1918, a state Senator from 1923 to 1924, and Pima County Assessor from 1927 to 1930.

He married Florence Ogden Cowan and they had five children: Rosalie, Cowan, Byron, Oscar and Allen. Drachman was active in the Masonic Order, Boy Scouts and other organizations.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection consists chiefly of scattered financial ledgers of the Harry A. Drachman Shoe Company including cash, daily journal, collections, sales, accounts payable, and customer account ledgers covering aspects of the company's operations from 1897 to 1930. Articles of incorporation and minutes for the Criterion Shoe Company are present. There are also photographs of Harry and Florence Drachman, their children, and their ancestors. The Odgen, Rice, Delaney and Tompkins families are related to Florence Drachman and the relationships are explained on the back of each photograph. Most of these are studio portraits. There are two oversize photographs; one of Morenci, and one of the Rough Riders regiment on horseback.

A 5-page reminiscence is present from Harry Drachman describing schools, an 1877 smallpox epidemic, and attacks by Apaches. There is a small amount of correspondence about bills in the State Legislature while Drachman was a senator. A ledger is present for the Arizona Health League, 1907 to 1910. Florence Drachman was secretary of this organization which was formed by a group of women to aid tuberculosis patients. An 1899 child's autograph book is present from Myra Drachman. There is also correspondence about the estate of Felix Levy and his book of recipes for prescriptions, written in German. Levy was a pioneer Tucsonan, employed at the Park View Hotel, and proprietor of the Opera Bath House.
