BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Real estate developer, civic leader and philanthropist, Roy Drachman was born in Tucson, Arizona in 1906 to Emanuel and Rosa Drachman. The Drachman family first settled in Tucson in 1868. Roy first worked in his family's movie theaters, then became manager of the Sunshine Climate Club, a group that promoted tourism, in the late 30s and 40s. He served in World War II before getting involved in real estate development, both locally and nationally, including land, hotels, and shopping centers. He was active in local and national organizations, advisory boards and committees especially those related to real estate and urban planning. In 1948, he worked with Del Webb to acquire land and sell homes in the Pueblo Gardens housing project. Roy was known for bringing Howard Hughes and Hughes Aircraft to Tucson in 1951 and is credited with contributing to the establishment of Tucson Medical Center and bringing the Cleveland Indians to Tucson for spring training. He was the author of two books: This is not a book: just memories, 1980, and From cow town to desert metropolis: ninety years of Arizona memories, 1999.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

Family documents and correspondence, sports memorabilia, clippings and articles, writings, and photographs relating to Roy Drachman's life, his family, business and philanthropic pursuits, from 1872 to 2002.

This collection is organized in six series: Series 1: Personal and family materials, 1872-1982; Series 2: Clippings and articles, 1945-1986; Series 3: Sports memorabilia, 1929-1973; Series 4: Photographs, 1898-2002; Series 5: Oversize photographs and printed materials, 1899-1950; and Series 6: Oversize scrapbooks, 1898-2002.

The earliest materials present are a few Tucson property deeds for family-owned property, dated 1872 to 1892, and photographs of the earlier generation: Emanuel, Mose, and Harry Drachman.

Newspaper clippings and articles concern numerous awards and tributes, reminiscences about family and Tucson history, and civic affairs, philanthropy, and real estate development. Of special interest are articles about urban renewal, the Pueblo Gardens Housing project, and the Urban Land Institute. Other topics include Chamber of Commerce activities, the Sunshine Climate Club, baseball and golf. Sports memorabilia includes Tucson Cowboys baseball score books and roster (1929), and a World Series radio score card and tickets.

Photographs are mostly of Drachman family groups and individual members but there are also photographs of downtown Tucson, the Fox Theater staff (1934-1937), and sports. There are images of groups gathered in tribute to Hi Corbett and of Tucson High School and Safford School class groups. A complete run is present of the *Tucson Week Ender* newspaper, 1933-1936. It presented a humorous, depression-era, commentary on Tucson mentioning social news, sports, recipes, and the stage and screen.

Four oversize scrapbooks contain clippings, memorabilia and photographs documenting Roy's life, both personal and professional. Highlights of Book A, 1898-1985, include childhood family photos, drawings and letters, World War II letters and photos, photos of John Schaefer, Del Webb, various philanthropic projects, and the dedication of Agua Caliente Park. Topics in Scrapbook B, 1986-1996, include the Drachman Institute for Land and Regional Studies, development and planning for Tucson and Pima County growth, groundbreaking for the Roy Drachman Boys and Girls Club clubhouse, photos with Rose Mofford, Maria Uriquides, and Carl Eller, and more. Scrapbook C, 1996-1998, includes information about History Makers, Malachy Hynes (publisher of the Week Ender), Urban Land Institute, various fundraisers, and Roy's Memory Lane columns. Scrapbook D includes awards, the dedication of Agua Caliente Park, and a chronology of 20th century Tucson history.
