BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Thomas R. Ellinwood, editorial cartoonist and executive editor of the *Arizona Daily Star*, was born in Bisbee and attended Amherst College and the University of Arizona where he was editor of the Arizona Daily Wildcat. After graduating from the University of Arizona in 1945, he went to work for the *Star*, which his family co-owned with the newspaper's publisher, William Rankin Mathews. Ellinwood's work included work in the business office, work as a reporter, copy editor, outdoor columnist and then as an editor and editorial cartoonist. In 1956, his column "Rod and Gun" became a feature in the *Star*. In 1957, he began drawing political cartoons commenting on the social and political atmosphere of the nation, Arizona and the Southwest. After his family sold the newspaper, he moved to a ranch in New Mexico. He died in 1995.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The entire collection is the published cartoons, caricatures and articles written by Thomas Ellinwood for the *Arizona Daily Star*. The collection relates to the variety of capacities held by Ellinwood with the *Star*. Thee newspaper clippings include his column "Rod and Gun," a sporting feature. Also included are articles by Ellinwood for the editorial pages and newsroom on a variety of subjects.

In both news articles and editorials, Ellinwood comments on the issues surrounding the Colorado River controversy over irrigation codes, gun registration, automobile safety, the mining industry and other local and state political concerns.
