HISTORICAL NOTE: In 2011, Old Tucson embarked on a project to build new movie-quality sets and restore the sets lost in a 1995 fire. The Heritage Square Project, a 5,000-square-foot design consisting of three new streets lined with 12 new buildings, was completed in November 2011 at an estimated cost of \$300,000. The project added dressmaker shops, a general store and a blacksmith shop for use in "living history" presentations. The design and construction of the new sets was led by Production Designer Gene Rudolf, who is credited with creating sets for many films including *Young Guns II* (1990), *Raging Bull* (1980), *Marathon Man* (1976), and *Three Days of the Condor* (1975).

**SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:** This collection consists of photographs of scale models of the buildings and of the construction of the buildings, which took place between July and November, 2011.
