**Hayden, Carl Collection**  
**1937 - 1968**

**DESCRIPTION**

This small collection consists of biographical essays, correspondence, newspaper clippings, and political literature associated with Carl Hayden between 1937 and 1968. Biographical materials entail two short essays on Hayden's life done in the early 1960s. Correspondence covers letters about historical topics and individuals of Arizona history. Correspondents include many individuals associated with the Arizona Historical Society including Eleanor Sloan, Mrs. George F. Kitt, Dr. Robert H. Forbes, Yndia S. Moore and Carl F. Miller. One golden anniversary dinner program dated 1961 commemorates Hayden's long work in politics. Campaign literature features the 1962 Hayden's reelection race.

**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Senator Carl Trumbull Hayden was born in Tempe, AZ October 2, 1877. He attended school in Arizona and graduated from Arizona Territorial Normal School (ASU) in 1896. After graduation he worked with his father in the flour-milling business in Tempe until 1904. In 1904 he was elected Treasurer of Maricopa County and then Sheriff in 1907. In 1912 Hayden was elected as a Representative from Arizona to the U.S. House of Representatives and served until 1927 when he was elected to the U.S. Senate. He represented Arizona and the United States in the Congress until January 1969 when he retired. Carl Hayden died January 25, 1972.
