HISTORICAL NOTE: The Civilian Conservation Corps, or CCC, was formed in March 1933 as part of the New Deal by Franklin D. Roosevelt in response to epidemic unemployment during the Great Depression. The project aimed to employ young men in labor that promoted environmental conservation. Nearly 3 million young men participated in CCC camps between 1933 until the program ended in 1942.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

This collection consists of the newsletters of various Arizona Civilian Conservation Corps camps. The newsletters, dated 1934-1937, contain not only camp news but also articles encouraging moral and patriotic behavior as well as articles on hygiene and work safety, jokes, cartoons, puzzles, poetry, and news of surrounding communities. Some newsletters from New Mexico, Oklahoma, Utah and Washington D.C. are also included.
