

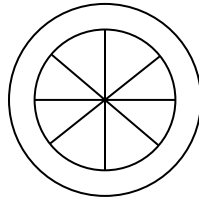
Flower Crown

Flowers grow all over Arizona, from purple irises in Flagstaff, to orange desert poppies, to the state flower, the white saguaro cactus bloom. You can find many colors in the flowers of Arizona. Make a flowery crown from a paper plate and flowers, either real or paper.

You Need:

- A paper plate
- Colored construction paper or tissue paper
- Paint, markers, or crayons
- Scissors
- Glue
- Optional-glitter, crepe paper or other ribbons

Step 1: Cut a slit through the center of the paper plate, leaving about an inch at the edge of the plate. Cut three more slits (shown below)



Step 2: Bend the triangles formed by the cuts upwards, forming leaf-like shapes. Paint the crown light green (or use markers or crayons to color it). Let the paint dry.

Step 3: Cut out some construction paper or tissue paper flowers for your hat.

Step 4: Glue flowers to the crown.

Step 5: Decorate it with glitter and/or staple two long ribbons of crepe paper to your hat.
