## **Arizona Historical Society State Board of Directors**

## **Executive Committee Meeting Minutes -- 29 Oct 2015**

On 29 October the AHS State Board Executive Committee met via teleconference.

Executive Committee Participants included: William Garbarino, Leonard Marcisz, Anne Woosley, George Flores, Tom Foster. Absent: Jim Ronstadt, Rachel Stallworth.

Others participating:

Staff: Bill Ponder, Chief Administrative Officer

The meeting was called to order circa 10:40am by chairman Marcisz.

## Key points:

- 1. Approval of minutes for the Executive Committee meeting of 17 September 2015 was moved by George Flores and seconded by William Garbarino. Passed on voice vote.
- 2. Dr. Anne Woosley, Executive Director, summarized the history of the Caborca baptismal font and aspersory, currently in the possession of AHS and for which negotiations are underway to transfer the objects, on loan, to the National Institute of History and Archaeology (INAH) in Mexico. Key points of the Woosley presentation:
  - a. The Caborca objects were acquired by the Murphey family during the early 20<sup>th</sup> century, from the Catholic Church authorities in Caborca, during the period of church secularization driven by the Mexican government.
  - b. The Caborca objects were subsequently bequeathed to AHS.
  - c. The Caborca objects will be loaned to INAH and held by them for public display in Caborca at an INAH museum rather than church facilities.
  - d. Display and care arrangements will be reviewed and approved by AHS.
  - e. The arrangement is a loan, not a repatriation.
- 3. Dr. Woosley then presented three documents which constitute the AHS agreement with INAH, and requested approval to proceed with arrangements for transfer. George Flores moved for approval. Tom Foster seconded. Approval passed on voice vote; no objections were received.
- 4. Memos of Understanding between AHS and the Southern Arizona Historical Society Docent Council and the AHS and the Arizona Pathfinders were reviewed and approved by the Executive Committee as authorized by the full AHS state board of directors at its 16 October meeting. Approval was moved by William Garbarino and seconded by George Flores. The motion was approved on voice vote; no objections were received.
- 5. The Executive Director's performance objectives for 2015 were reviewed for applicability and action. The following modifications were made:
  - a. Under the category of Management, Objective #2, references to "Sunset" and "closure" were removed in the interest of applicability and clarity.
  - b. Under the category of Management, Objective #2, George Flores was added as the board member responsible for conducting a survey assessing effectiveness of communications between AHS staff and the AHS state board, chapters, and support groups.
  - c. Under the category of Board of Directors Transition, Objective #1, George Flores was added as the board member responsible for conducting a survey assessing effectiveness of transition management and orientation of incoming board members.
  - d. Under the category of Membership, Objective #2, Kelly Corsette was added as the board member responsible for assessing effectiveness of legislative outreach
  - e. Under the category of Membership, Objective #3, dealing with communications with affiliates, the objective was eliminated on grounds that it lacked applicability to the current year.

6. The meeting was adjourned circa 12:30pm.
