### Day 1- Thursday, June 8

We depart from the Arizona Historical Society Museum, at 7:30 am, and after a brief passenger stop in Phoenix, we drive straight to Flagstaff where we will stop for lunch at the Galaxy Diner, a 50's themed restaurant featuring an all-day breakfast menu, burgers, and sandwiches. After, we will continue to Cameron to check in to our lodgings, and we will have time to shop at this historic trading post. Dinner this evening is at the Trading Post Restaurant.

### Day 2 - Friday, June 9

The next day starts at the Cameron Restaurant for breakfast, then we continue our trip to Third Mesa where we will tour a Hopi home and farmland with Michael Kotutwa Johnson. Next, we travel to Second Mesa for hotel check in and then lunch at the Cultural Center Restaurant. In the afternoon we will observe how a Hopi Kachina is carved by artist Larin Nasaavti, a Tewa/Hopi from the village of Tewa on First Mesa. Dinner is also at the Cultural Center, and in the evening Leigh Kuwanwisiwna, Director of the Preservation Office, will give us a presentation on his childhood experiences at an Indian Boarding School in Gallup, New Mexico.

## Day 3 - Saturday, June 10

Day three starts with breakfast at the Second Mesa Cultural Center Restaurant, and is a full



day to include Hopi dances, and Dorothy Ami's pottery demonstration at the Cultural Center.

Lunch and dinner today are at the Cultural Center Restaurant, Second Mesa.

## Day 4 - Sunday, June 11

The Cultural Center Restaurant is the location for our breakfast, after which we'll check out and head to Flagstaff. Lunch location is in the downtown area, followed by a tour of the historic Riordan Mansion, and then a visit to the Pioneer Museum. After the tour we will check in to the Marriott Hotel. Dinner this evening is a BBQ buffet at the historic Hotel Weatherford.

#### Day 5 - Monday, June 12

Breakfast at the hotel starts the day and then we proceed for check out. We will have a walking tour of Flagstaff's downtown area, and then we'll head back to the Pioneer Museum for an old fashioned Chuck Wagon lunch. We then board our bus and depart for passenger stops in Phoenix, and an approximate arrival in Tucson at 6 pm.
