



Janice Ryan Bryson is an Arizona native whose ancestors arrived in the state in 1881. A co-founder of the Irish Arizona Project and author of *Irish Arizona*; she is a columnist and writer of Arizona history. Janice is a member of DAR, The First Families of Arizona and is on the boards of the Arizona National Livestock Show, Arizona State Cowbelles and St. Patrick's Day Parade and Faire. She was named to the Arizona 4-H Leader Hall of Fame at the U of A for her work with youth. Honored as an Arizona Culture Keeper in 2008; Janice was also honored with the Anam Cara award from the Irish Cultural Center. The Arizona Cattle Growers presented her with the Top Wrangler award in 2014 for her dedication to the cattle industry in Arizona.
