

Still the least understood theater of the Civil War, the Southwest Borderlands saw not only Union and Confederate forces clashing but American Indians, Hispanos, and Anglos struggling for survival, power, and dominance on both sides of the U.S.- Mexico border. Arizona Territory was created during the Civil War and the conflict profoundly shaped the state we know today. Masich is President and CEO of the Smithsonian-affiliated Senator John Heinz History Center and teaches history at Carnegie Mellon University. He makes frequent appearances on the History Channel and the Smithsonian Channel, and won praise for his Emmy-winning historical documentaries, lively lectures, and books on American Indians, the West, and the Civil War. He served from 1978 to 1990 with the Arizona Historical Society in Tucson, Yuma, and Phoenix.
