The Silverbell Artifacts including the Desert Crosses

The AHS Arizona History Museum will display the Silverbell Artifacts including the Desert Crosses as seen on the H2 Channel's *America Unearthed*. The Exhibit will open Saturday March 2, 2013 and will remain on display for a few months.

In the 1920's, 32 uncovered lead artifacts were found proving to be one of the most bizarre and baffling incidents in Arizona History. Some believe that the artifacts prove the existence of a Roman colony in Tucson between 790-900 A.D.
