Katherine Allen Collection
1908 - 2003****DESCRIPTION**

This collection consists of materials pertaining to Katherine Allen of Yanceyville North Carolina and, later, Cortaro Arizona. Included are various newspaper clippings, personal correspondence, family photographs, financial receipts, banking papers, ledgers, and various miscellaneous family items. Additional materials relate to Katherine's cruise to the Pacific and S.E. Asia, to the funeral of Katherine Allen's Mother (Nannie Malloy), and to Katherine and Woodson Allen's marriage, constitute a small yet important portion of the collection. Further, the collection contains a number of brochures and other materials produced by organizations to which Katherine Allen held membership, such as United Daughters of the Confederacy, The Studebaker Drivers' Club, The Horseless Carriage Club of America, the Garden Club of Danville, and others. Materials related to the Malloy, Allen, and Pritchett families generally and, more specifically, to the individuals Stephen Malloy, Nannie Malloy, James Pritchett III, Woodson Allen, Mary Kerr Spencer, Mary Kerr Motz, and Lionel D Hargis are also included, although largely only insofar as they pertain to Katherine Allen.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Katherine Yancey Malloy was born May 20, 1915 in Yanceyville, North Carolina, to Dr Stephen A Malloy and Nannie Kerr Malloy. Her mother was a member of the prominent Yancey family for which Yanceyville was named. Katherine attended Meredith college and in 1940 married James Ira Pritchett III, a Danville Virginia business man who co-ran his family's firm, James I Pritchett and Son. In 1950 or 1951 James Pritchett died of heart failure at the age of 42. Katherine married Woodson H Allen in 1954 and moved to his home in Cortaro Arizona where Woodson ran the Black Arrow Lodge. Before 1954 correspondence with Woodson was addressed to the Mother Lode Lodge, which may or may not have been the same lodge under a different name. Throughout her life Katherine was a member of a variety of organizations, including the Garden Club of Danville, the Studebaker Drivers Club, the Veteran Motor Car Club of Arizona, the United Daughters of the Confederacy, and the American Red Cross. Katherine and Woodson Allen had the shared avocation of purchasing and renovating Studebaker cars. Katherine died December 30, 1999 and Woodson died February 21, 2008.
