DESCRIPTION

This collection consists of two small ledgers contain records for the Arizona Meat Company of Douglas, AZ. Records commence with the company by-laws signed in 1907 and conclude with the termination of the company and resignation of officers in 1940. Mortgage documents, Arizona Corporate Commission letter and blank cattle purchase forms are present. A newspaper announcement located in the back of the by-laws ledger announcing the formation of the company is also present.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The Arizona Meat Company was organized in 1907 at Douglas, AZ. Four company members were related family members including John I. Krentz, Frank I. Krentz, Joseph G. Krentz, and Louis E. Krentz. Principal business was the buying and selling of cattle and horses from area ranchers. The company lasted until 1940 when resignation letters from the principal company officials ended operations.
