Fred A. Baier, electrician, came to Arizona from Missouri in 1898. He worked for the Southern Pacific Company in 1920 as chief electrician and later worked for the Tucson, Gas, Electric & Light Company. He worked as Electrical Inspector for the City of Tucson in 1931 and retired in 1947.
