DESCRIPTION

The Brown papers consists of correspondence and reports concerning the mining and geology of Mineral Park, Mojave County, Arizona Territory. It includes a handwritten (16 p.) report by F. W. Speer to A. W. Thurman in Ohio. The report was sent from Mineral Park and describes the property in the Gold Basin mining district. The remainder of the collection is correspondence from Mineral Park, generally from Dr. A. L. Brown to J. I. Throckmorton. Most of the correspondence is original, but there are some letters where only a photocopy is present. Includes a hand-drawn map of the mines in the district.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Dr. A. L. Brown was a member of a syndicate headed by J. I. Throckmorton of Columbus. This syndicate included Allen W. Thurman, son of an Ohio senator. Thurman is mentioned extensively in the collection.
