## **DESCRIPTION**

The collection consists of numerous land deeds, recorded cattle brands, insurance policies and San Xavier School records, mostly between the 1890s and the 1940s. The San Xavier School records include teacher contracts for 1912, 1916 and 1917, as well as some enrollment figures, annual reports and business transactions. The collection also includes records of cattle ear markings, land transactions, and life and auto insurance policies for Elijo Burrue. There are some personal family records, including baptismal records, Elijo Burrue's 1917 draft card, and correspondence with the Special Mexican Claims Commission of the U.S. Treasury Department.

## **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

The Burrue Family owned and operated the Burrue Land and Cattle Company, and was involved with various mines in the Pima Mining District. Some family members included in this collection are Elijo Burrue, Joaquin Burrue, and Refugia Burrue de Ramirez. Elijo's grandparents, Pedro and Jesus Burrue, donated land for the San Xavier School. The family was associated with Albert Steinfeld and the Quiroz family.
