**DESCRIPTION**

Typescript copy of extracts from John Bushman's diary kept from 1867 to 1926, along with reminiscences from his family following his death, entitled "The Life and Labors of John Bushman : Son of Martin and Elizabeth Degen Bushman." The reminiscences relate significant family history, family events, Mormon settlement experiences and church activities.

**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Mormon pioneer; Bushman settled in northern Arizona in 1876. For many years following his death, the Bushman family continued to hold annual family reunions.
