DESCRIPTION

This collection consists entirely of photocopies and transcripts relating to the life of Adolph George Buttner. Includes information on Adolph and his son, Morris Samuel Buttner. Includes a copy of the military charges against Buttner (1868) for desertion. Includes copies of birth and marriage records for the family.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Adolph George Buttner was born in Prussia in 1847. He came to the United States as a child and enlisted in the Union Army during the civil war and came to Tucson in 1866. In Tucson, he served as United States Marshal and as the Chief of Police. He died in Tucson in 1885.
