DESCRIPTION

This collection consists of a history of five families associated with Corona Ranch Tucson (formally El Rancho Corona) near Sabino Canyon Arizona. Short historical summaries on each family or individual are accompanied with photographs and copies of relevant documents.

HISTORICAL NOTE

Corona Ranch history appears to commence in 1935 with Archie M. Meyer purchasing a parcel of land just south of Sabino Canyon on May 23rd. Meyer operated the property as a small guest ranch for visitors providing horses, rooms, and meals. The property continued to function as a guest ranch through successive owners until Terryl and Bobbie Varnum acquired the property in 1986 and the facility became a bed and breakfast for a short period. In 1997 with the hiring of Kerry Kruckmeyer the focus of the ranch shifted again to providing a location for planned events for patrons, organizations, and guests.
