**BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:** Roy L. Goodale was born in 1923. He attended Phoenix Junior College from 1941-1942 and in 1946. From 1942-1946 he served in the Army Air Forces as a private, captain and sergeant. After the army, he graduated in 1948 with a B.A. from Santa Barbara College (University of California) with a degree in social science. In 1950, he received a master's degree in history from the University of California, Berkeley. From 1950-1952 he was a salesman for Standard Oil. In 1955, he became an instructor in the Air Science Department at the State University of Iowa, now known as the University of Iowa where he taught courses in political science, geography and literature.

**SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:** This collection contains research notes on prominent Arizonans such as Herman Ehrenberg, Edmund Wells and Charles D. Poston. Research files contain correspondence, transcriptions, and copies of original documents. Of interest are letters or copies of letters written by Arizona Senator Carl Hayden to various institutions inquiring about materials on Charles Poston. It is not known how Goodale obtained these letters but it is clear he used this research for his unpublished manuscript written about Poston in Series II.

The collection is arranged into two series; **Series I: Research Files; Series II: Poston Manuscript.** Series I files are arranged alphabetically within that series. Series II is arranged by chapter number.
