Nogales and Old Glory Wagon Road
Papers, 1894-97**

DESCRIPTION

Two documents concerning the construction of the Nogales and Old Glory Wagon Road. One is an agreement of the townsmen of Nogales to tax for the purpose of building the road, 1894. This document contains signatures of Nogales residents. The second document is a letter from Arizona Governor B. J. Franklin to the Council of the 19th Territorial Legislative assembly concerning Nogales incurring a debt to build the Nogales and Old Glory Wagon Road, 1897.

Nogales (Ariz.) was founded in 1893. These documents appear to be the work of the residents to build a road from Nogales to Oro Blanco in Pima County.
