Photographs of Arizona towns and Sonoran mining operations. There are photographs in Tucson of San Augustine Church and Plaza, Tohono O'odham homes, adobe homes, and Alameda Street. Phoenix photographs include the Courthouse, City Hall Plaza, and a cigar store exterior and interior. There are also views of Prescott, and a Flagstaff lodging house and saloon.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Itinerant photographer; traveled by mule with his partner, George Edward Gommel, and photographed mining operations in Sonora, Mexico circa 1891. Allen also photographed scenes in Flagstaff, Prescott, Phoenix, and Tucson, Arizona and New Mexico between 1891 and 1893. George Gommel came to Arizona for his health in 1891 and died in December 1893 in Tucson.
