Hagan, Flossie Whipple

Hagan photograph collection, 1895-1933 (bulk 1900-1915)

DESCRIPTION

Family photographs of the Whipple and Hagan families in Clifton, and Pima, Arizona, ca. 1900 to 1915. Photographs of Clifton, Arizona include schools and school groups, ca. 1900-1916, an interior view of the Hagan Country Store, 1909, and Whipple family homes, ca. 1914. There are postcards of Pima, Arizona depicting a roundup, hotel, and street scene, ca. 1900-1915. There are also photographs of family and friends including Flossie Whipple Hagan, Roy Hagan, Edna Kline, Miriam Bond, Polly Hagan Finch and others. There are tintypes of Annie Laura Whipple and her doll, ca. 1895, and a cyanotype postcard of young men and women in Metcalf, Arizona, 1908.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Flossie Whipple was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. William M. Whipple, who settled in Arizona in 1876. She married Roy W. Hagan in September 1913 in Clifton, Arizona. Roy Hagan went to work for Phelps Dodge in 1918 and was general manager of Phelps Dodge Mercantile Co. at the time of his retirement.
