DESCRIPTION

This small collection consists of photographs related to the McClintock and Morgan family members who lived in southern Arizona. Almost all the images are portraits and photographs of individuals with over one half identified. Prominent family members in the collection include Kate and William McClintock, Walter and Bettie McClintock, Dick and Frank Wootan, Bill Wight, and Millie Upchurch. One image depicts Coolidge Dam and two mounted images show a ranch setting with either goats or sheep.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Wiley Morgan was born in Texas in 1864 and moved to New Mexico and Arizona in the early 20th century. He eventually built the I Bar Ranch near Klondyke, Arizona Territory by the Arivaipa River. Morgan was active with the Arizona Cattle Growers Association. He left ranching in 1945 and died in 1946 at Willcox, AZ. Wiley Morgan and his wife, Amanda S. Tomlinson, had one son named Burt and one daughter Bettie who married Walter T. McClintock.
