BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Dr. Purham Booker Purcell (1839-1924) was a prominent Tucson physician. He and wife, Mary Ann, had ten children including Sylvester, Purham, Jr., Louis, Maria, Teresa, and Ivy. His brother, Dr. Walter B. Purcell (1868-1910) was also a well-known Tucson surgeon with two children, George and Ethelyn. Purham's son, Sylvester W. Purcell (1870-1943) was a Tucson attorney who served as Pima County Probate Judge and was active in mining in the Sahuarita area.
