DESCRIPTION

Photographs, taken by Ray Reynolds, primarily of construction of buildings around Tucson between 1965 and 1970. There are images of the construction of the Tucson Community Center, Southern Arizona Bank, Pima Community College West campus, the University Medical Center, and the Greyhound Bus Terminal. There are also photographs of Anshei Israel Synagogue on 5th Street, Medi-Center on Wilmot Road, Motorola, Arizona Photo Center on Broadway, the Pima County Jail, St. Mary's Hospital, Tucson General Hospital, Pueblo High School, Burr-Brown, and El Con Shopping Mall. One image of the Sears building downtown also shows the Johnny Gibson Barber Shop. There are a few images of students at drafting tables, and secretaries working at the Skill Center and one view of the lake and visitors at Reid Park.
