DESCRIPTION

This is a small collection of photographs of the Sills family, friend and excursions taken mostly in the Tucson area between 1907 and 1914. There are images of horse-drawn carriages, homes of brick, adobe and grass including their home at 630 S. 3rd Avenue and the Manning house on Paseo Redondo, the Santa Cruz Valley ice plant wagon, a woman newspaper carrier on a bicycle, a woman cooking outdoors, and boys playing baseball. A few of the photographs were taken in Colorado.

Joseph H. Sills and his wife, Mae, are listed in the Tucson City Directories from 1908 to 1913. Joseph was a boilermaker for Southern Pacific Railroad. They built the house at 620 S. 3rd Ave. in Tucson.
