Thirty-five aerial photographs of Tucson taken in 1924, covering the area bounded by 29th St. to the south, Grant Rd. to the north, 12 Ave. on the west, and Campbell Ave. to the east. Additionally, there are two photographs covering one mile areas of South Tucson and Colonia Solana/El Encanto.

The photographs were taken by the U.S. Army Signal Corps on May 10, 1924 at an altitude of 5,000 feet.
