MS 184 PINAL COUNTY RECORDS, 1905-1918

DESCRIPTION

Two ledgers from the Pinal County Treasurer's Office. One ledger contains the 1905 letterbook kept by Emerson O. Stratton as treasurer for Pinal County. The copies of his original correspondence are concerned with accounts due to the county. The second ledger is the tax book for Pinal County from 1914 through 1918. Most of the entries are for personal property taxes in Ray and Sonora.

HISTORICAL NOTE

Pinal County was formed from parts of Maricopa and Pima Counties in 1875. In 1877, the county was modified slightly to correct a boundary error and it lost the Globe District to Gila County in 1881. The county seat is Florence.
