DESCRIPTION

A small collection, supporting the claim of Ana Otero Provencio against the estate of Teofilo Otero, comprised chiefly of letters from Teofilo to Anita (Ana), 1928 to 1940, but also including a typescript letter from Teofilo's sister Clara to him, 1901, newspaper clippings about Teofilo, a death certificate and will of Teofilo's brother, Sabino Otero, and a claim settlement document dated 1942. Also present are a few snapshots of Teofilo Otero, mostly from the 1930s, one studio portrait, and one photograph of tourists on an observation car in Vancouver from a 1928 trip.

HISTORICAL NOTE

Ana Otero Provencio and Edwardo Otero were children of a common law marriage between pioneer cattleman Teofilo Otero and Ann Otero Brown. At his death in 1941, they filed a claim against his estate.
