DESCRIPTION

Corporation records including a minute book, articles of incorporation, by-laws, as well as correspondence and stockholder records relating to dissolution of the corporation in 1912.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The Silver King and Florence Telegraph Company was established in 1881 to operate a telegraph line between Casa Grande, by way of Florence and Pinal to the Silver King Mine. The business was based in Pinal, Arizona; however, most of the directors lived in Florence. The original directors were Aaron Mason, William E. Guild, A. Venton, J. W. Anderson, and George A. Brown. Daniel C. Stevens was president of the board of directors from 1894 to 1912. The company was dissolved in 1912 and the line was converted to a telephone line.
