SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

The Small Manuscript collection is an active, artificial collection begun circa 1960 in an effort to aggregate historical materials, orphan documents, unpublished works, and fragmented personal papers into a "ready reference" for students. The Small Manuscripts Collection donated in 2012 to AHS by the Arizona Historical Foundation comprise the core of this collection. Files from the AHS's small manuscript collection were integrated during the process of removing duplicates, combining files, and evaluating the physical condition of the materials.

The materials in the collection were of insufficient quantity (5 folders or less) to merit a stand alone status. The donations came from multiple sources ranging from family histories for class assignments to items purchased from historical document dealers. The collection includes correspondence, eye witness reports, genealogies, diaries, old newspaper clippings, reminiscences, short stories, early histories of cities and towns, annual reports, and military documents.

The criteria used to determine the strengths of this collection were as follows: materials that provide insight into experiences of Arizonans from different perspectives; fresh and unique points of view on events in Arizona history; and materials that represent different political, cultural and minority experiences.

The overall condition of the materials is excellent and most fragile materials have been copied for researcher use.
