# MS 1075 Staehle, William C. Papers (1892-1900)

#### **DESCRIPTION**

This is a small collection of correspondence and legal documents relating to William C. Staehle who practiced law in Tombstone, Arizona Territory during the 1890s. The collection consists of information related to legal actions in Cochise County including two documents which refer to Frank Leslie, and correspondence to Staehle from C. F. Potter, Fiscal Agent and Broker, from Minneapolis, Minn. related to the Copper Crown of Arizona Mining Company in Cochise County.

# **BIOGPAPHICAL NOTE**

William C. Staehle practiced law in Tombstone, Arizona Territory from approximately 1890 to 1900. Sometime after that date he moved to Cairo, Ill. Voting registration information for Cochise County indicates Staehle was registered in 1890, 1892, and 1898. In 1892 the Cochise Co. Great Voter Register listed him as a lawyer, 39 years of age, born in Germany, and a naturalized U.S. citizen.

The collection was donated by Margaret Fitzgerald in 1992. The materials were found in a house in Cairo, Ill. where Mr. Staehle lived after moving from Arizona.
