## HISTORICAL NOTE

The Agency Pima County Bank was opened in Tombstone in the spring of 1880. It was a branch office of the Pima County Bank in Tucson begun by Lionel and Barron Jacobs. The name was changed in 1882 to Cochise County Bank. Safford, Hudson & Co. was organized by former Governor A.P.K. Safford, James H. Toole, John Wasson, and Charles Hudson late in 1878. James Carr was a lumberman and freighter in Tombstone; Albert Thomas Jones worked as agent for Carr's Huachuca Mountain sawmill and was Justice of the Peace in Tombstone.
