H. M. Van Arman, Secretary of Arizona, was born in Ohio and raised in Illinois. He served in the Civil War and was wounded at Shiloh. He worked for various newspapers in California and was appointed as Secretary of Arizona Territory in 1882 under Gov. Tritle. He died in California in 1904.
