One letterbook (480 pages) of the Vekol Mine in Casa Grande, Arizona from 1885 to 1887. The letterbook, which is faint and difficult to read, was kept for the business correspondence of the Vekol mine. Correspondence is primarily concerned with supplies and is signed by John D. Walker and W. H. Merritt.

HISTORICAL NOTE

The Vekol mine, located on the Tohono O'odham reservation southwest of Casa Grande, operated between 1885 and 1916. The silver mine was run by John D. Walker and Peter R. Brady.
