DESCRIPTION

One ledger of the Women's Universal Benevolent Association in Tucson, Arizona for 1895-1896. The ledger lists names of members making monthly donations to the Association. It does not give information as to how the funds are expended. Names in the association's records include many prominent Tucsonans. Officers of the organization in 1896 were Mrs. J. A. Black, Mrs. S. H. Drachman, Mrs. A. V. Grossetta and Mrs. J. Ferrin.

HISTORICAL NOTE

Though we have no information on the Women's Universal Benevolent Association in Tucson, many women's religious, self-improvement and community improvement associations were popular in the late nineteenth century. We have only the records of the treasurer in 1895 and 1896, which record the moneys raised and not the benevolent activities of this particular association.
