The World Peace Through Law Section of the State Bar of Arizona was formed in 1989 to foster world peace and justice through respect for international law. Specific objectives include the promotion of a greater public understanding of the substance and process of international legal principles and the facilitation of debate within the legal profession on issues of world peace. The Section convenes monthly meetings to develop strategy for accomplishing these broad objectives, and actively encourages participation in these meetings by lawyers, law students, judges and others.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

Arranged in six series. Each series is organized alphabetically and chronologically within.

Series I: Arizona Bar Association - Includes running of the section of the Arizona Bar Association, including its history and bylaws. The Correspondence files include general correspondence, planning materials for the yearly convention, meeting agendas, membership lists and research materials and articles. The special task force on sections was established by the Arizona Bar Association and includes information on the section and a justification of why the section should remain apart of the Arizona Bar Association

Series II: Case Files - Contains information regarding various subjects that the World Peace Through Law section of the Arizona Bar Association was interested in. The Case Files are separated by subject area and are chronological by date organized within. These include, International Arbitration, Civil Rights, Cyber Security, the Death Penalty, The Gulf War,

Immigration, Indian Affairs, The International Court of Justice, The Irish Republican Army, Militarism, Nicaraguan Aid, Nuclear Weapon Policy, and War Tax Resisters. The case files also include initiatives the World Peace Through Law section endorsed such as the European Union, The Five Continent Peace Initiative, and the Binding Triad.

Series III: Convention Materials - Convention materials include the resources provided at the Arizona State Bar annual convention, these include programs, brochures, notes and seminar reference material. Organized chronologically.

Series IV: Projects and Seminars - Contains information as well as developed material for a variety of projects the World Peace Through Law section the Arizona State Bar participated in.

Series V: Publications - Includes Pamphlets and Newsletters both produced by the World Peace Through Law section as well as promotional materials produced by guilds and other sections that are associated with the World Peace Through Law section of the Arizona State Bar. Organized Alphabetically. Also Collection of published works from the August Eckhardt memorial archive. Includes hard-to-find publications and pamphlets. Organized by authors last name.

Series VI: Media - Includes Steve Doncastor's collection of political cartoons as well as cassette and video tapes of recordings of World Peace Through Law members. Presentation topics include U.S. policy on Nicaragua, discrimination against women, reports on the United Nations, human rights and refugees.
