**Guest register, 1883-1913**

**DESCRIPTION**

Book of inscriptions and autographs by U.S. Army officers and other guests who visited Cooley's ranch near the Fort Apache Indian Reservation between 1883 and 1913. Also present is one letter from Gen. George Crook, Sept. 1, 1883, thanking Cooley for curios received.

Merchant; came to Arizona in 1860 as an army scout, later settled in Showlow, Ariz. where he operated a lumber and mercantile business.
